The SeniorNet newsletter usually comes to you by email around about the 24th of each month. The other alternative is that the newsletter always goes on-line into our webpage as soon as it is finished, again around the 24th of the month. The link to the webpage is: www.whangarei.seniornet.co.nz

On the front page of the web page on the left hand side you will see a row of buttons, click on the one that says 'Newsletter' this will open the page you need and then you click on the word 'Newsletter' which is in blue type underneath the penguin. This should open up the newsletter immediately. You will need the programme Acrobat Reader installed on your computer to be able to read it. Most computers come with a version of Acrobat reader already installed on it.

Anyone who does not have access to the internet will be able to pick up a newsletter from our rooms around about the 26th of the month, free of charge. Please ring the rooms beforehand as the rooms may not be in use.

One reason you might not be receiving the newsletter is that your ISP server is putting it into your spam folder or blocking it. Another reason is that SeniorNet doesn't have your correct details e.g. a wrong email address. Many people change their addresses and don't let us know.
